


Above: America250 parade route

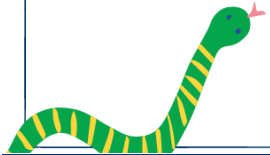

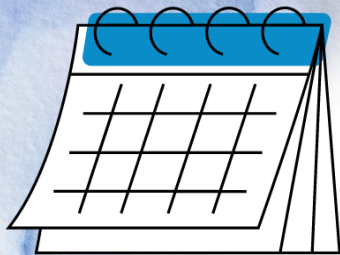
